This two story one room School House was moved to Sundre on November 11, 1972. Originally twenty-two ladies, representing thirteen organizations met to discuss plans for a new thrift store. When the thrift store outgrew the Mayton School House, Mr. Chester Mjolsness helped the thrift store get relocated to a new location more suitable to their needs and the museum acquired a new building. This building is beautiful with its gorgeous large schoolhouse windows and open spaces. It is most suitable for groups that do not have accessibility issues because the old building has stairs.

Youth Round Building

This delightful round building was designed and built by local youth under the direction of Neils Eskesen. It features beautiful natural skylights and warm in floor heating. This building is most suitable for smaller groups who need accessible spaces. It offers a private street entry as well as it can easily be used in conjunction with a village rental with its 2nd emergency doors having village access. This space has two washrooms, a wall screen for presentations, a coffee or amenity service area and comfortable seating options.

Pioneer Village

Pioneer village encompasses four beautiful acres located in Sundre's Riverside District surrounded by the museum's memory fence on the north and chain link to the east, south and west. This area backs onto the campground. Scattered throughout the village are unique historical buildings, quaint building replicas, and wide-open green spaces.
